

Tahiti Golf Open International 2019 MOOREA GREEN PEARL GOLF COURSE

From September 23rd to September REGULATIONS FOR AMATEUR COMPETITION

I - CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

Tests opened to French players and international players, **meeting r**equirements for rules of amateurs' status of rules of the status of amateur, licensed by FFGOLF or a recognized foreign federation. The players must have a medical certificate of not contraindication to practice which, **for the players licensed in France, will have to be recorded by FFGOLF before the beginning of the competition. Otherwise registration will be rejected.**

For the international players not licensed in France, the medical certificate will have to be given during registration.

II – PRO AM FORM OF GAME on September 23rd

Scramble - classification in gross and in net (gross prevails over the net) **1 Pro + 2 to 3 amateurs (Index brought back to 24,4) Departures:**

- Pro: Black
- Amateurs misters

1st serie: White 2nd serie: Yellow

• Amateurs ladies:

1st serie: Blue 2nd serie: Red

Golf Cart are included between holes 10 and 18.

III – DEPARTURE TIMING

Shotgun 9 AM. - Convocation at 8 AM (PRO SHOP reception desk of the MGP)





Every player will have to come ready to play 30 minutes before departure. In case of late departure, the conditions of rule 5.3a will apply.

<u>V – FORFEIT</u>

Any forfeit will have to be notified to the Committee of the competition 2 days before the beginning of the competition at the latest. Every player who forfeit after this delay remain liable to pay the competition fees, except cases of force majeure.

VI – PRICE

Will be attributed:

- 1 price in net (by team)
- 1 price in gross (by team)

VII – OPEN FORM OF GAME from September 24th to September 27th

Simple Stroke Play / 72 holes with a cut at the end of the third day / classification in gross and in net.





- Misters: 1 serie (index limited to 24)
- Ladies: 1 serie (Index limited to 24)

Departures:

• Misters:

Black index inferior or equal to 4,9 White index superior to 5

• Ladies: Blue (position of cones will be corrected by hole according to difficulties).

Teams are constituted of 2 pros and 2 amateurs the first two days

The best amateurs (mixed classification) will be kept for the cut at the end of the 3rd day (number of chosen players established according to the number of participants – 30 players maximum chosen)

VIII – DEPARTURE TIMING

Departures in Shotgun at 9 AM the first 3 days,

Departures from hole 1 and hole 10 the last day (reversed order from the classification at the end of the 3rd round).

Display of timetables on the board.

Every player will have to come ready to play 10 minutes before his scheduled time of departure. In case of late departure, the conditions of rule 5.3a will apply.

<u>X – FORFEIT</u>

Any forfeit will have to be notified to the Committee of the competition 2 days before the beginning of the competition at the latest. Every player who forfeit after this delay remain liable to pay the competition fees, except cases of force majeure.

<u>XI – PRICE</u>

Will be attributed:

- Misters: 3 prices gross
- Ladies: 3 prices gross

XII – DECIDE BETWEEN EX AEQUO

In case of equality, to determine the classification, it will be done with the best of 9, 6, 3 and, then, if equality remains, hole by hole by going back up.

XIII – RECORDING

To avoid any dispute, the players will have to apply by the following procedure:

- All players of each group imperatively have to come together at the recording, and after the last hole. The not present players with their co-competitors will be considered as having returned their card "as soon as possible " and therefore contravening with the rule 6.6.b.

- **Players are invited to wait for their card to be verified.** The card will be considered as returned, according to the terms of the rule 6.6.c, when the player will leave the recording place.

XIV – COMMITTEE OF THE COMPETITION

The Committee of the competition reserves the right to change the form of game, to cancel all or part of the competition or to apply it with an inferior or superior number of players or on an inferior or superior number of days to initially scheduled.

- Committee: Mr Christian LAUSAN Mr Jean Pierre LORMEAU (and amateurs referee)





XV – SLOW GAME

The federal norms of cadenza of game will have to be strictly applied.

The procedure in force issued by the Committee of the Rules of FFGOLF will be applied. The Committee of the competition will have any authority to make it respect.

XVI – BEHAVIOUR AND DRESS CODE

A proper attire, in line with the golfic traditions, is demanded on the ground (bermuda sportwear, or trousers, <u>polo with collar</u>). **Therefore jeans, T-shirts, tank top are forbidden.**

If a player acts in a wrong way (throw of club, blow of club in the soil, the bag or the trolley, rude words, etc), he will have, after warning, a 2 strokes penalty. **In case of dangerous club throw or of serious breach to the etiquette,** the player will be immediately disqualified by the committee. Also, in case of insults to a member of the Committee or to a referee, the Committee will be able to pronounce the disqualification of the player.

Attention: The use of mobile phones, MP3 is not allowed and will be able to be penalized, after warning, by 2 strokes penalty.

The use of the Golf Cart will be organized between holes 12 and 16.

XVII – OFFICIAL BOARD

The players will have to acquaint themselves with all information and/or possible modifications on the regulations and the process of the competition on the official board. Only information appearing on this board is to take into account.

XVIII – PRIZE GIVING

On Friday, September 27th during the Closing Ceremony from 6 PM in Tahiti. Cocktail reception: 5 000 xpf per person. Reservation at registration or with the agency Tahiti Expert Event: contact@tee.pf
